Requirements: Must be a resident of Sausalito

Purpose: The purpose of the Committee is to provide a forum to share comments, issues or concerns regarding public safety, including but not limited to crime prevention, community outreach, policing programs, and disaster preparedness education and training; foster stronger police/community relationships as it relates to Community Policing; encourage public participation in crime reduction strategies; review and recommend changes to the City's Disaster Plan and City-wide evacuation plan; provide recommendations to the City Council on disaster preparedness programs; encourage citizen education in disaster

preparedness and resilience; encourage citizen participation in disaster preparedness activities.

Historic Landmarks Board

Two pre-existing vacancies to be filled

Length of Term: 2 years

Meets: On a monthly basis, or as needed

Requirements: Must be a resident of Sausalito; it is desirable for members to have training, experience, or a demonstrated interest in historic preservation (licensed architects are encouraged to apply).

Purpose: The purpose of this Board is to review applications for exterior renovation of historic or noteworthy structures, historic sites and landmarks located throughout Sausalito. This Board also promotes preservation of historic sites, landmarks, documents, paintings and objects associated with the history of Sausalito; recommends to the Planning Commission that certain historic sites, landmarks and districts be designated and/or acquired by the City; advises the City Council on the acceptance of donations and/or acquisitions of items with historic value to the City; advises the City Council on matters relating to the historic and cultural preservation of the City. *Since the City has qualified for CLG status, new regulations for this board must be taken into consideration: "Commissions must have as minimum of five members with all members having a demonstrated interest, competence or knowledge of historic preservation. Commission members shall be appointed from among professionals in the disciplines of architecture, history, architectural history, planning, archeology, or other historic preservation-related disciplines, such as urban planning, American studies, American civilization, cultural geography, or cultural anthropology, to the extent that such professionals are available in the community. Commission membership shall also include lay members who have demonstrated special interest, competence, experience, or knowledge in historic preservation, American studies, cultural anthropology, cultural geography, or other historic preservation-related disciplines".*

Parks and Recreation Commission

Meets: On the second Wednesday of the month

Requirements: Must be a resident of Sausalito

Purpose: The purpose of the Parks and Recreation Commission is to advise the City Council on planning and policy matters relating to the services provided by the Parks and Recreation Department; advising the Parks and Recreation Department and Public Works Department on planning and policy matters relating to the creation, operation, maintenance, management and control of all parks, playgrounds, community recreation programs and activities; advising on the management, execution, installation, or placement of the public art in public

places within the City; and receiving community input concerning parks and recreation activities as well as public art.

Purpose: The purpose of this Commission is to advise the City Council on ways and means of meeting solid waste diversion goals and hazardous waste management goals established by the State in local plans; plan and undertake public education and public relations programs to encourage residential and commercial participation in recycling and waste reduction programs; advise the City's designated garbage and recycling collectors(s) on ways to improve the operations and accomplishments of these programs; advise the City Council on waste management issues related to Countywide and/or regional plans and programs; develop and disseminate information about products and materials which contribute to waste reduction and solid waste diversion goals; evaluation of garbage collection and recycling; and advise the City Council on projects that meet the present needs of people without endangering the welfare of future generations and with the goal to support the ability of the environment to continue to function properly indefinitely by minimizing environmental degradation, and to halt and -where possible- reverse the processes they lead to.
