Hello,

I'm a resident of Sausalito. I have lived here for 3 years with my wife and 8 year old daughter (Marin Ave.) We made Sausalito our home after living in Los Angeles for 20 years. As a young family with a child, the attraction of Sausalito is strong, with the community it offers, schools, and locations like Schoonmaker and MLK park. The proposed high density housing at MLK is a heartbreaking development.

There are serious concerns regarding the LFSF school, which will certainly be negatively impacted, if it isn't displaced all together.

The MLK park is where kids learn to ride bikes, celebrate birthdays, play soccer, baseball, lacrosse, etc. It is already challenging to find locations where children and families can gather in Sausalito. The lack of consideration for current families in Northern Sausalito is unacceptable. It makes Sausalito less attractive for families.

The traffic in Northern Sausalito during sports events or community fairs results in heavy traffic and strains the parking and safety in that area. The freeway access from Bridgeway is already currently stressed with traffic backing up on Bridgeway and surrounding streets. The traffic on streets like Nevada and Coloma are currently challenging to walk/cross safely. The idea of concentrating more traffic in this area is alarming.

I don't approve of losing a substantial portion of MLK park or burying the LFSF school in high density housing.

Please let me know how I can file my opposition to the proposed housing development at MLK Park.
