Dear City Council,

My husband and I love Sausalito, we are both concerned citizens, and feel that Sausalito's current housing plans for the MLK park are headed in exactly the wrong direction. This is absolutely not the appropriate spot for such housing. There are so many other viable areas that would be a much better solution. New housing is being pushed to the northern tip — including low-income units in a public park—while vacant lots and office buildings remain unused.

I urge you to:

- Remove MLK as an opportunity site.
- Revise city ordinances (particularly Ordinance 1022) to reinstate local building control rather than being locked into a closed-door plan created exclusively for state and HCD requirements.
