Dear Members of the Sausalito City Council,

I urge you to remove MLK Park from the list of housing development sites in Sausalito. This current proposal would:

- **Eliminate Park Land:** MLK Park's playing fields, courts, and community spaces serve schools, recreation, and local events. Developing housing here permanently reduces this essential space.
- **Cause Severe Parking & Traffic Issues:** Schools like Lycée Français and New Village School rely on MLK Park's parking for small children starting age 2 years old. Removing it will create major challenges for young parents and add congestion on local streets already busy with school and recreational traffic.
- **Disrupt Local Streets:** Nearby roads, which serve multiple schools and community facilities, will see increased gridlock and safety concerns.
- **Overlook Better Alternatives:** Marinship has multiple underutilized lots that can accommodate housing without sacrificing vital public land.

Please prioritize preserving MLK Park and direct housing development to more suitable locations in Sausalito like Marinship which has multiple sites.
