



MARINSHIP COURT MEMBERSHIP AGREEMENT

Marinship Courts include 2 courts designated for tennis and 3 courts designated for pickleball.

Keys

Court keys are non-transferable and may not be duplicated; Doing so will result in forfeiture of key(s) and fees.

Memberships may be purchased any time online, but you will need to be issued a key card or granted access in an app to use the courts. Keys can be issued during the Recreation Office business hours: Monday-Thursday 10am-5pm. Contact recreation@sausalito.gov or 415-289-4152.

Court keys are property of the City of Sausalito. Please return your physical key card to our office upon membership termination, so that we may re-use it.

Memberships

Memberships are valid January 12, 2026-January 10, 2027. Memberships can be prorated by the month if available and purchased later.

Members must be at least 16 years of age. Anyone under the age of 18 must have parental consent to purchase a membership.

Keyholders listed in a Household Membership must reside at the same address.

Business Memberships must have a Sausalito business address. The key is transferable between employees. This membership may only occupy or reserve one court at a time. During Mon-Fri 11 am-3 pm; if other courts are available, then you may use up to 2 courts. Online court reservations will supersede the additional court.

Reservations/Time limits

Reservations and City-sponsored programs supersede other play. Otherwise, courts are available on a first come, first served basis. Members can reserve a court at Sausalito.gov/Marinship or by calling 415-289-4152 during business hours.

Each keyholder can reserve courts 3 times a week (Sunday-Saturday) for a maximum of 1 hour time slot on any day. Courts reservations open 5 days ahead at midnight on a rolling schedule.

Tennis Court #1 and # 2 can only be reserved for tennis play. Tennis Courts have pickleball lines and rolling nets that may be used for pickleball play, if pickleball courts are full. Court rules apply.

Reservations will have a 15-minute grace period. After 15 minutes from the start of the original reservation, if the reservation holder does not show up, they will forfeit that reservation. Walk-ons are allowed after this grace period to play for the remainder of the hour (45 minutes). If another reservation isn't in queue, play may continue for the full hour or longer. If players are waiting for the court without a reservation, current players must vacate the court after 60 minutes of total play time.

Guests

An Individual Member may bring one guest to the courts per visit. Household membership keyholders may bring 1 guest per present keyholder to the courts (up to 2). Each member (and their guest) may only occupy 1 court at a time.

Membership Rules

In addition to adhering to the posted rules, anyone using Marinship Courts is responsible for proper use and care of the courts and Marinship Park's facilities. Common tennis and pickleball court etiquette will be expected and must be observed at all times.

Lessons, exhibition matches, or tournament play are prohibited at Marinship Courts unless organized or approved by the Sausalito Recreation Department. Any person who violates these provisions shall be deemed a trespasser, shall be guilty of an infraction, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine and their membership terminated.

Any violation of the agreement or posted rules will result in termination of your membership, including an immediate deactivation of key(s) and forfeiture of any fees.

MARINSHIP COURTS RULES

(These rules are posted at the courts)

FACILITY USE RULES

1. Court hours are 8:00AM-10:00PM. Use of the courts between the hours of 10:00 PM to 8:00AM is prohibited.
2. Courts are reserved exclusively for Marinship Court Members ("keyholders").

Memberships allow access to the named keyholder and one guest per member.

- i. Marinship Court Memberships are available for purchase online at Sausalito.gov/Marinship or at the Sausalito Recreation Office at 420 Litho St., Sausalito.
- ii. Keys are non-transferable; Doing so will result in key deactivation and fee forfeiture. Keyholders must provide identification to verify their membership to City of Sausalito staff upon request.
- iii. Members must always be present when their key is in use. Lending keys to others is not permitted.
- iv. Anyone under 16 years old must be accompanied by an adult.
3. The gate must be closed and locked at ALL times. Never prop open the gate.
4. No tailgating. Each member must use their key for access. When you follow another member that has opened the gate before you, you still must use your key to enter.
5. Courts are for tennis and pickleball use ONLY. No animals, bicycles, roller skates, scooters, or skateboards allowed.
6. Please keep the courts clean and safe by using the trash and recycling receptacles.
7. No food, drinks (water permitted), alcohol, tobacco products, or chewing gum are allowed on the courts.
8. No amplified music.
9. No pulling, climbing, or hanging on the nets or fences.
10. All players must wear sneakers.
11. Players should inspect courts before playing and play at their own risk.

COURT RULES

1. Lessons, exhibition matches, or tournament play are prohibited at Marinship Courts unless organized or approved by the Sausalito Recreation Department.
2. Four Ball Limit: You may use up to four balls. Ball machines or mechanized teaching aids are not allowed on the courts at any time.
3. Court reservations and City-sponsored programs supersede other play. Otherwise, courts are available on a first come, first served basis.
 - a. Each member may reserve 3 times a week (Sunday-Saturday) for a maximum of 1 hour time slot on any day Sausalito.gov/Marinship
 - b. Membership will not be required to participate in City-sponsored programs.
4. Two or more players are allotted up to 60 continuous minutes of total court time if players are waiting.
 - a. If players are waiting for an available court, current players must vacate the identified court after a total of 60 minutes of court time.
 - b. Players waiting for an occupied court should clearly communicate their intention to use a selected court to the current players.

Sausalito Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to refuse court entry to anyone for failure to abide by these rules. Authorized personnel may revoke access privileges at any time.

Rules, regulations, and rental fees are subject to change.

*Per Sausalito Municipal Code 13.28 the use of courts for lessons, without the prior payment of the fee is unlawful and an infraction. Any person who violates these provisions shall be deemed a trespasser, shall be guilty of an infraction, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$500.00.
