NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Sausalito City Council will hold a public hearing beginning at **7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, FEBRUARY 5, 2019** in the City Council Chambers at City Hall, 420 Litho Street, Sausalito regarding the Interim Adoption of Permit Fees for Accessory Dwelling Unit Permits, Amnesty Accessory Dwelling Unit Permits, Junior Accessory Dwelling Unit Permits and Amnesty Junior Accessory Dwelling Unit Permits as an Urgency Measure and Establishment of Fees for Accessory Dwelling Unit Permits, Amnesty Accessory Dwelling Unit Permits, Junior Accessory Dwelling Unit Permits and Amnesty Junior Accessory Dwelling Unit Permits. The proposed fees are as follows:

Accessory Dwelling Unit Permit: \$1,200
Amnesty Accessory Dwelling Unit Permit: \$400
Junior Accessory Dwelling Unit Permit: \$810
Amnesty Junior Accessory Dwelling Unit Permit: \$270

If adopted, the urgency measure adopting the above fees would be in place from February 5 through March 7, 2019. The permanent fees would be effective beginning on April 6, 2019.

What will Happen. You can comment on the proposed fees. At the February 5, 2019 meeting the City Council will consider all public testimony and decide whether or not to proceed with the adoption of the fees. The City Council may also decide to continue the public hearing, or request additional information.

Letters for the City Council received by noon on Wednesday January 30, 2019 will be included in the Staff Reports. Materials submitted after the distribution of the agenda packets will be available for public review at the Community Development Department during normal business hours, at the City Council meeting, and on the City's Website: www.sausalito.gov (subject to Staff's ability to post the documents prior to the meeting).
