**PROJECT SUMMARY:** The Applicant, Nina Manzo, on behalf of owner, Lloyd Silverstein, is requesting modifications to an approved Design Review Permit (Project ID: 2021-00043) for building modifications to the existing mixed-use structure at 2-8 Princess Street. The proposed modifications include changes to the style of the rear deck guardrails, the elimination of planters and privacy screens on the rear decks, interior reconfiguration of kitchens in units 2 and 3, and a change in location and type of gas heaters in units 1 and 2. This project has been determined to be categorically exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) of the CEQA Guidelines.

**WHAT WILL HAPPEN:** The Community Development Department will consider all public comments submitted by the deadline and decide whether to approve, deny, or modify the project. You will only be notified of the official action if you submit written comments by the deadline (below).
